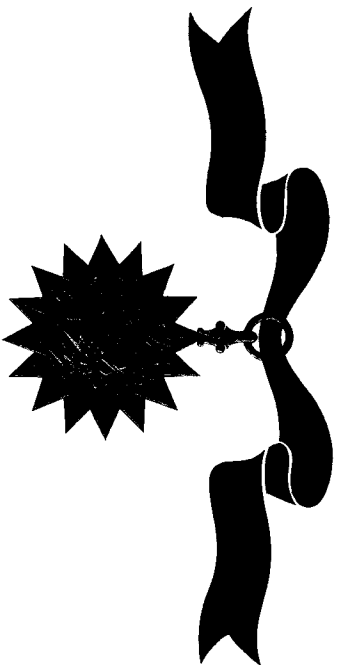
CITATION:

For meritorious achievement while participating in aerial flight as a Pilot attached to Attack Squadron ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO embarked in USS ORISKANY (CVA 34) in combat operations in Southeast Asia from 11 July 1966 to 23 July 1966. In the successful completion of nine strikes against the enemy and two flights on combat missions in an active combat area, Lieutenant Feldhaus contributed substantially to the success of the United States efforts in Southeast Asia. By his professional skill, noteworthy achievements, and complete dedication to duty under hazardous conditions, Lieutenant Feldhaus reflected great credit upon himself and upheld the highest traditions of the United States Naval Service.
